

FINALLY ROYALTY REALIZED

Billy was crowned king of the First Swimming Man Festival in Burlington, VT. Collaborator, good friend and inspiration Poppa Neutrino was among the organizers. Billy's performance chops and 2,367.4-mile Mississippi River Swim made him an obvious choice. He asked what he'd have to do. Poppa said, "Just get here and be willing to perform and we'll take care of the rest."

He headed out with her majesty Margarita, who would later be crowned queen of the festival. The journey included a 5-hour Lake Michigan crossing on the SS Badger, a Canadian drive to Montreal, then south to Burlington and finally the festivities in, on and around Lake Champlain.

He helped finish-up the raft/stage just as the Coast Guard asked them to move on. They set sail for the planned performance site with makeshift paddles, but a storm forced them to land and lash off for the night. The raft was seaworthy, but its scale made it a little difficult to maneuver. It was large enough to accept the tall silk flying apparatus for aerialists from the Lady Circus House of Yes, along with instruments, equipment and a bevy of performers. It was guerilla theater at its finest - no permits - just a strategically anchored stage among all the yachts and beachcombers gathered for Independence Day

Fireworks. John Pendergast motored in to back Billy on several free jazz numbers before the king jumped overboard to finish his signature "River Rap" with strokes and splashes. There was a radio appearance and video screenings to round out the trip.

STILL WORKING FOR PEACE - PART 1

从艺术到谋杀的祭献美学

THE SACRIFICIAL AESTHETIC: BLOOD RITUALS FROM ART TO MURDER 艺术家 Billy X. Curmano

明尼苏达艺术家Billy Curmano的行为艺术"血浴Bloodbath"被西方媒体暴力行为的关注,艺术家流着自己的鲜血作为全人类的祭祀。"

Bloodbath由Billy表演被祭献的人,他所强调的,是表演全部使用新鲜血液式表演通常被安排在颇具象征意义的2月14日西方情人节。Billy身着白衣坐表演者将流洒鲜血作为祭品以减缓人世间作为付出的痛苦与死亡。Billy保证血,但并不会严重伤害到自己。他身边的护士用针管从他手臂中抽出鲜血灌音贯穿其中。最后Billy用牙齿撕开药瓶,将鲜血洒向身旁的地球仪,落幕的在冲突的地区。

Stay with us now. It's a little tricky. Last issue (Vol. 33), we led with "Timeless or Time Will Tell". In 2009, Euro Arts magazine re-created Billy's 1984 anti-war work, "Bloodbath", with an art historical article by Dr. Dawn Perlmutter taken from an earlier issue of UCLA's Journal of Anthropoetics. There was a lengthy excerpt with blood curdling quotations like "The artist's own blood is shed in a human sacrifice intended to focus attention on global violence."

Déjà vu all over again as *Vision*, Beijing China's art and fashion magazine, re-created it once again in their April 2010 issue. They kept the doctor's title, "The Sacrificial Aesthetic: Blood Rituals from Art to Murder", eight images and the players names in English. The rest was All-Chinese. Since we don't understand it, ...let's just say it's all good.



PART 2: MIDNIGHT BABYLON

"Midnight Babylon" has a colorful past. It premiered at the Cat Club in NYC in the early 70's and once split the bill with legendary performer Country Joe MacDonald. It was dusted off and recreated for Winona's first Fringe Festival and then again for the Burchfield Penney Art Center in Buffalo, NY. It was written and performed as a highly mutable solo piece that travels easily and fits most any venue and time frame - from 1 minute as a commercial for peace to a full hour performance. It was meant to stand-alone or be used between acts at concerts and other events. The babble in Babylon focuses on the nightmares and posttraumatic stress of a warrior. It has remained relevant as we continue to send people off to that abomination that is war and expect them to reintegrate back into our society - even though they've been forever changed.

PART 3: OXY THE SMART BOMB

Billy comes by his anti-war stance honestly. He has been witness to war on two continents, carries a 6.5 mm steel ball in his calf, several other scars and was once asked to participate in the VA Medical Center Study of Brain Function and Posttraumatic Stress Disorder. He's envious of the resiliency of cartoon characters and longs to be one.

His cartoon strip and sometime alter ego "Oxy"

THE WATER TRILOGY

Billy's "Water Trilogy" connects the abundance of water from his Mississippi River swim with its absence in the 40-day Death Valley Desert Fast and goes on to the changing states of the Arctic. As he developed it, bits and pieces appeared here and there, but it's finally a "formal" work available for touring. Appropriately, the Trilogy premiered and helped inaugurate the brand new Cascade Meadows Wetlands and Environmental Science Center in Rochester, MN along with other special events and the "Women & Water Rights Exhibition". The new environmentally friendly facility sports two different types of wind generators, solar collectors, lots of green amenities and educational programs.

Legend has it the project began with simple plans to restore the wetlands with nature trails and an

educational kiosk. It snowballed from there. A tip of the proverbial hat to the far sightedness of the Water Matters Coalition for bringing the arts, science and audience together in Rochester.


"HISTORY OF DISAPPEARANCE:

Live art from New York" the group exhibition with Billy's "Swimming the Mississippi" video is still touring internationally. Most recently, it was at Arhus Kunsbygning (the Center for Contemporary Art) in Copenhagen, Denmark. We sometimes lose track of these things and only find out by Googling Billy with the goo-goo googely eyes (Couldn't resist that). Franklin Furnace (NYC) organized the exhibition and - so far - we know it's been at museums in England, Italy and Venezuela.

MAEP

Billy recently ended his 2-year term as a panelist for the Minnesota Artists Exhibition Program (MAEP). MAEP controls two dedicated galleries in the Minneapolis Art Institute and is the only artist run curatorial program in a major institution in the U.S. The artist panel is elected from the art community at an annual meeting. He was honored to serve in this unique program for the second time. Every 10 years, the program includes a massive "Foot in the Door" exhibition open to all MN artists. The works must fit into a one cubic foot box known as the "Curator". Time based works limited to one minute each were included for the first time in 2010. Billy responded with his environmental short video "Earth Speaks".

Incidentally, he continued the now long-standing tradition of playing solo incidental music in the fountain court before the annual meeting.

AROUND TOWN AND ...WITOKA

Closer to home, Billy performed and/or screened solo work for Winona State University, Riverway Learning Community, and Winona's Family Art Day. He animated a logo for the Midwest Musicfest and performed with New X at their first annual festival. The band has been active in the studio and at Ed's Bar. The MWMF animation and clips from some of the New X shows are on You Tube. The main studio and Witoka Contemporary are still in renovation. After a \$500 fee and hearing, the septic system drain field was finally approved. Alas, a chink in local legislation caused a pause. A FASEM NOTE: Billy retired his position on the Board to devote more time to his projects.
